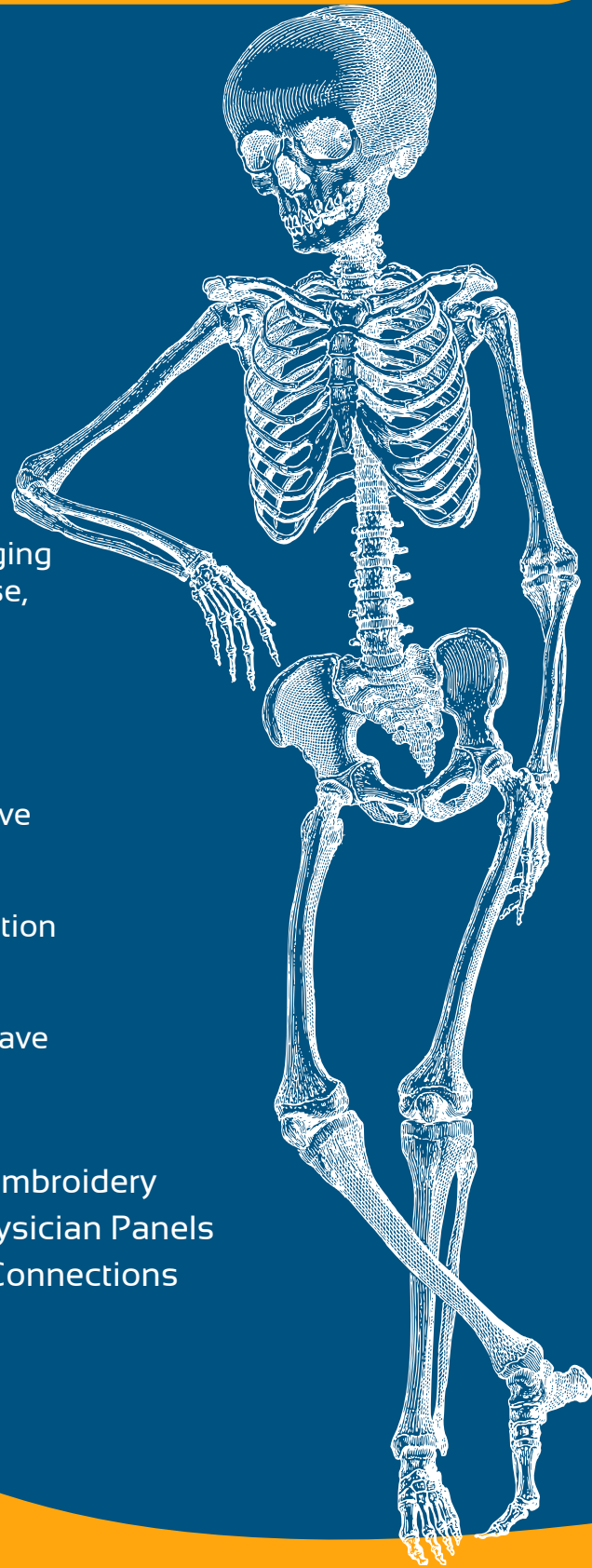
Interventional radiologists: physicians who use medical imaging to guide minimally invasive surgical procedures that diagnose, treat, and cure many kinds of conditions. Imaging modalities used include fluoroscopy, MRI, CT, and ultrasound.

Diagnostic radiologists: physicians who interpret medical images using x-rays (radiographs, CT, fluoroscopy), radioactive substances (nuclear medicine), sound waves (ultrasound) or magnets (MRI). Radiologists also treat diseases by means of radiation (radiation oncology or nuclear medicine).
