

Please be sure to pay close attention to deadline dates. As a note, this website will be updated regularly with additional information, so it is important to check the website frequently!

Required Online Modules

During Orientation Week (Tuesday and Wednesday), students will be asked to complete a variety of required online modules. These presentations will be posted by the evening of July 15th and must be completed by the end of the day on July 17th. You will be able to access the online modules on the Orientation website under the tab Online Modules-Complete by July 17.

Registration

You will need to complete a number of online forms, attestations and modules to assist you with the registration process. See the Orientation website to access this information. Please note that you will be required to bring the completed registration form with you to campus. You will be able to access this form on the Orientation website under the tab Bring to On-Campus Session on July 15. You can submit this form following check-in on Monday morning or on Friday, July 12th at the Student Services Fair.

Academic Schedule

Please refer to One45 for your class schedule, grades, and evaluations. The One45 link can be found on the Orientation website and additional training for using this platform will be covered during Orientation Week. All course materials and echo links, etc. will be posted in Canvas.

Student Health Insurance Program

All Rowan-Virtua SOM students are required to have active health insurance, accepted in NJ, and therefore must waive or enroll in the student health insurance plan. If you have health insurance through another insurer and seek to waive participation in this coverage, you must complete the online waiver form by **September 23, 2024**.

TO WAIVE OR ENROLL IN AETNA STUDENT HEALTH:

- 1. Go to University Health Plans
- 2. Enter your Date of Birth and Student ID
- 3. Click on "Continue"

The university plan is Aetna Student Health, and you may view the Summary of Benefits and Coverage under Benefit Information on the University Health Plans website.

Some highlights of the Aetna Student Health plan include:

- Premium \$6,676
- Coverage period: July 15, 2024- July 14, 2025
- PPO Plan No referrals
- \$350 in-network deductible
- In-network urgent care centers \$40 copayment for urgent visits, non-urgent visits are not covered
- In-network wellness and preventative care covered at 100%
- In-network Primary Care office visits \$30 copay
- In-network prescription drug coverage (Annual \$250 RX deductible)

Please note that you will be required to provide information regarding your plan. Have your insurance card in front of you when completing the waiver. Once you have completed the waiver you will receive an email from University Health Plans providing you with a confirmation number. Please keep this confirmation for your records. The health insurance fee will be removed from your bill within 10 business days. If you already paid this premium, it will be refunded by the <u>Bursar's Office</u>.

Please note, waiver submissions will be reviewed by University Health Plans. If University Health Plans is unable to verify your insurance coverage is active, Rowan University will enroll you in the Aetna Student Health plan and your account will be billed accordingly.

Big/Little Match Program

All first-year students are expected to participate in the Big/Little Match Program. First year students will be paired with a second-year student during Orientation Week. To facilitate the pairings, please complete the Big/Little survey for your curriculum track no later than July 7th. You can access the surveys on the Orientation website under the tab **Due by July 7**.

We will be hosting a **Big/Little Meet-Up on Tuesday, July 23rd at 5 pm on the green outside of the Academic Center in Stratford.** We strongly encourage you to join your "big" for some lawn games, music, ice cream, and more! Big/Little Match assignments and additional opportunities to meet and connect with your "big" will follow in your university email during Orientation Week.
