Dear Member of the Class of 2030,

Congratulations on your acceptance to Rowan-Virtua School of Osteopathic Medicine! We are very pleased to have you join the Rowan-Virtua SOM family. We are writing to provide important information that will help you prepare for the Orientation in July.

By now, you should have received information from Dr. Todd Schachter, the Rowan-Virtua SOM Director of Student Health, regarding the health requirements needed for matriculation at Rowan-Virtua SOM. These materials **MUST** be returned by the deadline date stated in the letter you received upon acceptance to Rowan-Virtua SOM. *Failure to complete and return these materials on time may affect your acceptance and/or ability to start with your class.*

Your Orientation Week experience unofficially begins on Friday, July 10th with optional programming and early distribution of your personal laptops. The official Orientation for the Class of 2030 is scheduled for **Monday, July 13th through Friday, July 17th.** All entering students are **required** to participate in the Orientation Week programs and are strongly encouraged to attend the optional programming on July 10th. Orientation Week programming is primarily in-person with some programming offered online and through virtual sessions. We are finalizing the schedule for this important week and expect to provide a confirmed schedule by mid-June. At this time, we can provide the following highlights about the Orientation Week experience we are planning for the Class of 2030:

- Orientation Week will include a mix of virtual learning presentations, online coursework, small group workshops, and in-person sessions.
- We are working on a variety of presentations and activities to acquaint you with the campus, curriculum, faculty, staff, and one another.
- Peer engagement activities are also planned, including an outdoor BBQ event, a Big/Little match, and a session to share key strategies for surviving first year, just to name a few.
- The Orientation Week sessions will include a Welcome Program for the students who will call the Sewell campus home and a campus tour for all members of the class of 2030, who will have full access to the campus, including the classrooms, library, and study areas.
- Required Basic Life Support courses (three dates) will also be offered for members of the class.
- Finally, we've created a website with important information for you to begin at the School of Osteopathic Medicine. The website will be the primary means of communication for important Orientation information, including schedules, presentations, student organization information and new student requirements. We realize you may have many questions at this time. We are also planning a virtual information session for the incoming class on **Tuesday, June 23rd at 5:30 pm** to make sure you are prepared for Orientation Week and beginning medical school at SOM. At this session, you'll hear from the leaders of admissions, student affairs, student health, curriculum and more. You can find more information about this session, including the Webex link, in your email.

Classes for first-year students on both campuses will begin on Monday, July 20th.

All members of the class of 2030 will also participate in the White Coat Ceremony – a rite of passage for all medical students at the Rowan-Virtua School of Osteopathic Medicine – on Friday, August 7th in Pfleeger Theater on the Glassboro Campus. To accommodate your large class size, we will host two ceremonies: 4:00 pm and 6:30 pm. A large, outdoor reception will be held in between the ceremonies for all students and guests.

Students will be able to select their ceremony time and RSVP for up to three guests. Both ceremonies will also be livestreamed for all family and friends to view. More information about your White Coat Ceremony and the event registration will follow via email in July.
