Dr. Randel Swanson is an Assistant Professor of Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation at the Hospital of the University of Pennsylvania (Penn), with sub-specialty certification in Brain Injury Medicine. Dr. Swanson's clinical practice centers on the Neurological Rehabilitation of patients with Acquired Brain Injury, both at Penn and within the Polytrauma TBI System of Care at the Corporal Michael J. Crescenz VA Medical Center. His goal is to assist patients in achieving optimal return of neurological function following all forms of Acquired Brain Injury through a combination of clinical practice and scientific research. Dr. Swanson is a funded investigator within the VA's Center for Neurotrauma, Neurodegeneration and Restoration (CNNR) and Penn's Center for Brain Injury and Repair (CBIR).
